The Sheriff's deployed numerous new strategies in an effort to manage calls for service related to fireworks activity resulting from the 4th of July.

Citizen Connect App:

This year, the Sheriff's Office utilized the Santa Cruz County Citizen Connect App. to better communicate with county residents about fireworks activity. The APP was used in the following manner:

Mapping of historical fireworks calls for service from 2015

Provide a reporting tool for local residents to identify fireworks activity prior to the 4th of July Provide residents an additional fireworks reporting method during peak times on the 4th of July Provide personnel in the field with an interactive map identifying "hot spots" and areas impacted by excessive fireworks activity.
